Doctor Arthur Llewellyn-Lloyd OBE KStJ JP



The second Patron of the Birmingham Medal Society from 1989-2014 and its President from 1979-89, Dr Arthur Llewellyn-Lloyd O.B.E. K.St.J JP sadly passed away peacefully on Thursday 27th February 2014 aged 86 years

'Doc' Lloyd served as a Captain in the Royal Army Medical Corps during his National Service and during the Malayan Insurgeny in 1952. He was later a respected GP in Small Heath, Birmingham for 40 years, a Justice of the Peace and retired senior St John Ambulance Officer.

It was Doc Lloyd who having served under Lt. General Sir Alexander Drummond, K.B.E., Director General of Army Medical Services, introduced him to and asked him to give the first Annual Drummond Lecture to the BMS in 1979 on 'Military Medicine'.

The Doc would often entertain members of the BMS with his talks on his latest medallic acquisition, given with such gushing enthusiasm and naturally we are saddened by the loss of such a valued friend within the Ordecomedology world.

Doc's funeral will be held on Friday 7th March 2014 at 11.00am at St Edburgha's, Yardley Old Church, Church Road, Yardley, Birmingham, B33 8PD. Followed by Burial at St Etheldreda's, Horley, Oxfordshire at 3.30pm.
